Have the following checklist ready before you call:


- Contractor/Contact Number
- Caller's Name
- Contact Person/Additional Information
- Date of Excavation
- Start Time of Excavation
- County, City or Township
- Location of Work – Street Address
- Intersecting Streets/Roads
- Distance From Intersection/Direction
- Extent of Work Front/Rear/Both Sides
- Type of Work
- Non-member utilities should be notified individually, however, if an underground utility is damaged as a result of the owner not being a member of the call center, damages cannot be recovered.
- Violations of Tennessee's Damage Prevention Act are subject to fines up to \$2500 and/or 48 hours in jail.





Color Codes for Locating Utility Lines

-  RED – Electric Power Lines, Cables Conduit and Lighting Cables
-  YELLOW – Gas, Oil, Steam, Petroleum, or Gaseous Materials
-  ORANGE – Communication, Alarm or Signal Lines, Cables or Conduit
-  BLUE – Water, Irrigation and Slurry Lines
-  GREEN – Sewers and Drain Lines
-  PINK – Temporary Survey Markings
-  WHITE – Proposed Excavation

Tolerance Zone: Width of Underground Facility Plus 24" on Each Side
